Reporting to the Manager Aquaculture and Inland Fisheries (MAIF) and Executive Manager, Fisheries Management the Fisheries Management Officer- Aquaculture and Inland Fisheries (MOAIF) will be responsible for assisting in managing inland fisheries and aquaculture developments and specifically applying any management plans that may be developed affecting these fisheries, by working closely with the Manager and Provincial Government and community groups to develop and apply programmes that meet sensible biological , environmental, sociological and economic considerations, developing a responsible working relationship with the stakeholders particularly the community and land and water owners, whilst continuing to contribute to policy development initiatives.

Essential Competencies

- A Degree in Fisheries Science, Fisheries Economics, or Business with some years experience in fisheries research , development or management with specific experience in Inland Fisheries and Aquaculture.
- Demonstrate an ability of computer literacy skills in word processing, spreadsheets, and diagrammatic charts and graphs, along with an excellence in oral and written communication skills to produce management reports and discussion papers to enable responsible and sensible management decisions to be taken or recommended.
- Demonstrate a familiarity with key issues affecting management of the inland fishery, particularly food security, community ownership and environmental concerns, along with a clear understanding of the policy environment including the importance of a viable private sector, and the value of the fishery to the community.
